#### **INTRODUCTION**

Southern Route Stations - There are over 544 stations in the Southern region, they are the main gateways for 700 million passenger journeys each year. Some of the more notable stations in the region are London Waterloo, Britain's busiest station, London Victoria, ranked number two and London Bridge ranked number four.

#### THE CHALLENGE

Network Rail's public facing staff at stations, are regularly exposed to challenging situations, including managing difficult members of the public, dealing with general anti social behaviour and handling intoxicated persons. Without the use of body cameras, the Station Staff responded to several situations which escalated into abusive confrontations, leading to racial, verbal and at times physical abuse.



### THE SOLUTION



#### WCCTV BODY WORN CAMERAS & CLOUD EMS

- 1 WCCTV chosen as preferred supplier of body worn cameras.
- 2 Camera's front facing screen shows the subject they are being recorded to deter incidents from occurring.
- 3 Staff feel safer which leads to a reduction in stress and sickness due to incidents.
- (4) Cameras act as an evidence gathering tool which can then be used to assist in cases which go to court.

## THE RESULT
